

#### Infrastructure and Facilities:


- Neat and Clean school premise with facilities like RO, CCTV, playground, outdoor and indoor activities.

- Remedial classes for Reading Challenged children






### **Enrolment**

■ Beginning of the Year ■ End of the Year




### **Average Attendance**

## Average academic performance of children



### **Major Highlights:**

- > 5 students selected in Medhavi Pariksha in 2017-18 and 3 students in 2016-17
- ➤ 4 Gold medals won at central zone sports meet in 2017-18 and 2018-19
- ➤ 1st prize in Folk dance, Fancy dress costumes
- > 2nd prize for the Innovative Science Model and 1st prize at Zonal Science Meet
- >90% average retention
- > Community participation: >200% average increase (increase from 20-25 to 70-80)
- > Teachers adopting the Story Pedagogy and prepare modules by themselves
- Infrastructure work have been completed swiftly such as park, boundary wall, gardening
- > Supportive principals
- > Teacher steadily adopting pedagogy 80% adoption
- Operators' staff and SDMC teachers gelling well now

#### **Challenges:**

- Inadequacy of teaching staff.
- The teacher-students ratio for a class is disturbed and hence affecting performance of the children.



### **Katha's Education Model**

Story Pedagogy through Active Story Based Learning (ASBL) Use storybooks, not textbooks as teaching-learning materials.

Teacher as a performer. Rooted in India's ancient treatise on dance, the *Natyashastra*.
